

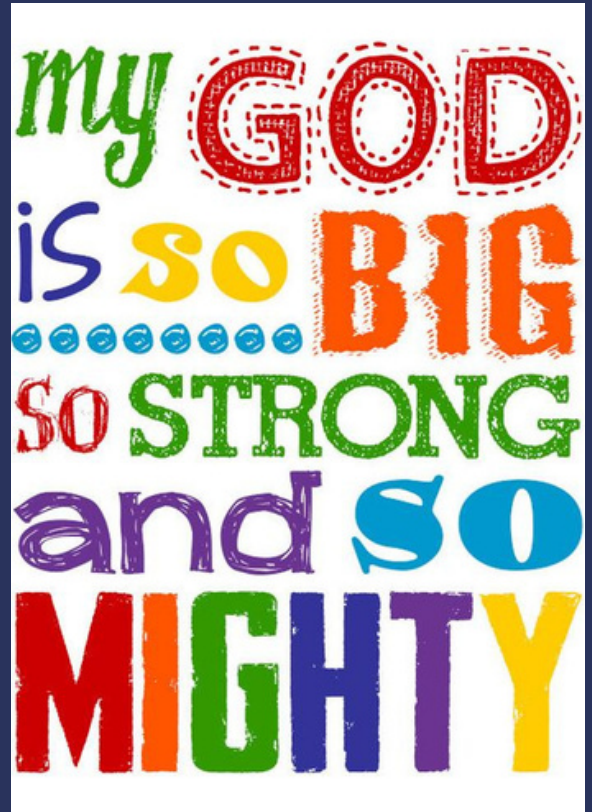


Children & Family Newsletter
